

## ANTECEDENTES

Como base para este informe comenzaré con una explicación general de lo que hacemos los recién egresados en el espacio laboral y terminare con la actividad actual que realizo en la Cd. de Monterrey, Nuevo León.

En mi caso muy personal comencé desde antes de salir de la carrera, de acuerdo a las habilidades adquiridas y a las necesidades que tenía en ese momento la búsqueda de un trabajo fue siempre primordial, meses antes de salir empecé impartiendo clases de computación en la carrera de programador analista, lo encontré agotando todas las posibilidades preguntando, bolsas de trabajo, ir a las instituciones educativas, periódico, donde en esta última alternativa conseguí el puesto antes mencionado. Me dieron una oportunidad y seguí adelante, continué en este trabajo y traté de llevarlo con la carrera, después comenzó la asignación del servicio social, en este caso quise que se me asignara en el edificio de Juárez y Enrique Díaz de León, salí sorteado en el área de estadística, comencé a ver nuevos productos informáticos, y así sucesivamente, realice un pequeño sistema para el área; quería que se me contratara en alguna área dentro de la Universidad pero no fue así. Aún no dejaba mi trabajo de instructor, a unas semanas de salir, decido hacer practicas profesionales en el Grupo Financiero Inverlat, fui aceptado para realizar dichas prácticas pero sin ningún ingreso, eso era desmotivante pero seguía echándole las ganas, el único aliciente era aprende todo lo que puedas y sigue adelante, conocí el funcionamiento de las comunicaciones.

Comencé a buscar trabajo en otro lado, tengo compañeros que en aquel tiempo realizaban también prácticas profesionales en diversas empresas y tenían contactos. Una de mis compañeras, me envió con uno de sus contactos, concerté una cita, no me resolvieron nada y aquí también era como practicante, al cabo de los 15 días, me mandan hablar de la empresa contacto para practicas profesionales y me dicen que estoy contratado para ir a trabajar en un proyecto en la Ciudad de Toluca, Estado de México, para mí era mi primer trabajo formal, nunca había viajado, no conocía Toluca, y fue donde rompí el cordón umbilical de mi familia, mi gente y de la Ciudad de Guadalajara, y con lo que había ganado hasta este momento me sirvió para el viaje.

En la Cd. de Toluca comencé en el proyecto de implementación en la empresa Farmacéuticos Lakeside del sistema SAP R/3 System en las áreas de Compras, Planeación, Ingeniería Industrial, Producción e Inventarios. Participé en todos estos módulos, pero en el que me dediqué a fondo fue en el área de Compras y Planeación. Pasaron los meses, se terminó el proyecto y regresé unas semanas a Guadalajara, después en la misma empresa se abrió un nuevo contrato para implementación del sistema SAP R/3 System, para la empresa antes mencionada en la Cd. de México, ahora mi papel sería ser líder del proyecto en las áreas de Contabilidad, Cuentas por Pagar, Cuentas por Cobrar y Contraloría

Una vez terminado los proyectos con esta empresa, se me envía a Oracle México para formarme en las áreas Oracle y después impartir cursos Oracle y como comentario aquí es donde empieza la travesía, los viajes, los temores, miedos y logros dentro de una empresa que me daría prestigio, oportunidades, crecimiento, etc.

**ORACLE CORPORATION**

Hasta este momento he hablado de mis antecedentes en la búsqueda y lucha de oportunidades, a continuación comento algunas características de mi gran empresa Oracle Corporation.

Oracle es una compañía dedicada a ofrecer un rango completo de software y servicios basados en el Sistema Manejador de Bases de Datos Relacionales ORACLE (RDBMS), ORACLE RDBMS es líder en el mercado con miles de instalaciones alrededor del mundo y de diversos sectores en el mercado, todos ellos con el propósito de dar la mejor solución en estrategias de información dentro de diferentes negocios.

La empresa empieza en 1977. En 1979 Larry Emson y Bob Miner (dos de las personas más importantes dentro de la compañía actualmente) implementaron la idea del reporte técnico de IBM, el cual hablaba sobre el SQLR que fue el sistema de recursos humanos del cual surgió el lenguaje SQL. Ellos escribieron el primer SQL basado en una base de datos relacional. Otra importante decisión fue tomada también en 1979, escribir el código en lenguaje C. Ellos tomaron la idea de IBM y la hicieron portable a través del lenguaje SQL, de hecho la máquina que probó dicho desarrollo fue una computadora DEC llamada PD11. Oracle toma su nombre de un primer contrato, un proyecto confidencial para el gobierno, el password de ese proyecto de seguridad era precisamente ORACLE. Larry y Bo decidieron llamar a la compañía como dicho concurso. La compañía inicialmente se encontraba situada en Menlo Park. Actualmente se encuentra en San Francisco.

Hasta ahora la compañía se encuentra en 95 ciudades alrededor del mundo, cuenta con 7,500 empleados aproximadamente, además ocupa el primer lugar dentro del mercado de los RDBMS's y el tercer lugar en ventas de software.

La arquitectura cliente-servidor, explota al máximo la tecnología más avanzadas, incluyendo aquellos sistemas que incluyan multiprocesadores (SMPs). La base de datos distribuida ORACLE permite acceder en una sola consulta, datos que se encuentren en servidores remotos.

La arquitectura abierta de ORACLE provee una transparencia de acceso a los datos de otras bases de datos relacionales como DB2 y SQL/DB de IBM, e incluso aquellas que no son relacionales, como DBASE de ASHTON TATE.

Las aplicaciones del mundo real demandan el acceso concurrente de los datos críticos, con la mayoría de los sistemas de bases de datos los sistemas pueden convertirse en una barrera de contención con el desempeño limitado, no precisamente por la capacidad del CPU o lecturas y escrituras sobre disco, sino por los usuarios que tienen que esperar el acceso a los datos. ORACLE utiliza un bloqueo a nivel registro irrestringido y consultas libres de contención, que minimizan y en algunos casos eliminan completamente tiempos de espera.

La filosofía de ORACLE involucra diversos conceptos, como son: COMPATIBILIDAD, PORTABILIDAD, CONECTIVIDAD, CAPACIDAD Y PRODUCTIVIDAD. La compatibilidad es hablar de una gama de productos, los cuales se rigen bajo los estándares de la industria de las bases de datos relacionales, lo que produce que una base de datos sea compatible con otras

bases de datos existentes en el mercado. Una aplicación de ORACLE puede ser transportada de una máquina a otra, con diferentes sistemas operativos y esto no provoca ningún cambio o modificación a dicha aplicación, esto habla de la portabilidad que ofrece ORACLE. La arquitectura de ORACLE permite que los datos y las aplicaciones residan en diferentes computadoras, plataformas, sistemas operativos y ambientes de red, la idea es tener una conectividad completa. La capacidad de manejo de grandes volúmenes de información facilita el uso de aplicaciones grandes. Además ORACLE cuenta con diversas herramientas y productos que apoyan en la toma de decisiones para lo cual se cumple la productividad.

## FORMACION Y EVALUACION DE INSTRUCTOR

Cuando se desea formar un candidato obviamente se requiere autorización de Oracle México, analizar el perfil del candidato, autorización por el Coordinador en Oracle México y por el Coordinador en el Centro Autorizado; donde se requiera trabajar.

Dentro del perfil para ser instructor se requiere ser persona y que le guste enseñar, independientemente del área o la cátedra, ya que estará con un grupo de profesionistas: dentro de los cuales encontraremos gerentes, líderes de proyecto, analistas, programadores, usuarios etc. Al mismo tiempo que serán personas del sector público y privado.

Cuando se haya analizado el perfil, y el candidato haya sido aceptado, el siguiente paso es la docencia, se expondrá un tema de cualquier área; analizándose así su manera de impartir y desenvolvimiento personal ante los grupos.

Por ultimo una vez pasada la prueba de didáctica se procede a formarlo en los cursos de Oracle, este procedimiento puede llevar meses, y puede ser a través de prácticas, programación, análisis, diseño e implementación de sistemas o de productos Oracle al término de este período es necesario evaluar los conocimientos, estos se harán mediante una sesión con personas expertas en el curso correspondiente y mediante la técnica de lluvia de preguntas se hará dicha evaluación.

Estos procedimientos se avalan mediante las políticas establecidas por Oracle que a continuación se mencionan.

### Políticas administrativas para instructores a partir de 2000

1. El instructor se asignará primeramente a un grupo para el nivel indicado.

GRUPO I tronco común, developer

GRUPO II Oracle 8 (dba) dss

Independientemente del grupo y del nivel se pagará al instructor un 5% adicional sobre la hora si imparte los siguientes cursos (excepto los del grupo de designer) cualquier curso que tenga web, datawarehouse, ola, osa, dba, no calendarizados (replicación simétrica)

2. A partir de 1 de Enero de 2000 quien no este certificado se le pagará 50% de la tarifa vigente de certificado en proceso adicional, difícilmente se le asignaran cursos. Quien no tenga al menos un examen no se considerara en la planilla de instructores.

3. Cuando un instructor SENIOR quiera dar un curso nuevo que nunca ha dado se le pagara respetando su nivel de senior pero tendrá que dar el curso como segundo instructor al menos 4 veces y no se le pagaran es decir:

Primera vez, apoyo en practicas.

Segunda vez, impartirá no mas del 50% de los temas.

Tercera vez, impartirá no más del 80% de los temas.

Cuarta vez, impartirá del 100% de los temas.

De acuerdo al resultado en la cuarta se decidirá si es necesario una quinta vez.

4. Estas tarifas serán las mismas para todos los centros autorizados. Cada instructor deberá de ir a firmar contrato con cada centro autorizado. El centro autorizado asignará o cancelará directamente el curso a cada instructor. Cada instructor de es libre de contratarse por tiempo con un centro si así lo desea, de ser así es importante que se sepa la situación de cada instructor.

5. Oracle de México sigue siendo el responsable de toda la parte académica de los instructores, es decir, autorizar instructores a cursos, llevar su curriculum académico, capacitarlos. Se emitirá cada instructor los cursos que este autorizado a impartir.

6. Las cancelaciones en Oracle de México se manejarán igual que 1999, suponer que el curso indica el lunes 20.

7. Si se cancela el lunes 20, viernes 1, jueves 16 o miércoles 15 se paga el 100% si se queda en la oficina o el 50% si no se queda en la oficina, esto lo define el OAEP o coordinador académico, teniendo prioridad el 50%

30% si se cancela el martes 14 o lunes 13.

15% si se cancela del viernes 10 al lunes 8.

Las cancelaciones se harán a más tardar el último día antes de las 18:00 hrs. al lugar indicado por cada instructor para recibir mensajes.

8. Referente a los viáticos se manejaran de acuerdo a las políticas vigentes Oracle de México y de cada centro autorizado.

## EDUCATION COORDINATOR

En este tema quiero compartir con Uds. El análisis del puesto adquirido actualmente, esta es una descripción general de las funciones de un Coordinador Educativo Oracle.

### Proceso de impartición de cursos Oracle

Antes de que se imparta un curso en las instalaciones de la Facultad de Ciencias Físico-Matemáticas en la Universidad Autónoma de Nuevo León es necesario realizar lo siguiente

#### *Preparar el curso:*

En esta función estamos en contacto con soporte técnico Oracle y llevar el status de la Base de Datos, usuarios, scripts (prácticas en el cliente y/o en el Server), checar que el producto sea el adecuado del lado del cliente; en algunas ocasiones a soporte técnico se le olvida y en este caso lo tenemos que realizar en línea, es decir cuando el curso se está impartiendo lo cual quita imagen y tiempo al curso. Todo lo anterior es si nos confirmaron a tiempo en caso contrario se tiene que hacer fuera del horario o esperar a que se desocupen las salas o se preparen nuevos equipos. Por eso consideramos como fecha límite los viernes al mediodía para cerrar cursos.

#### *Estudiar el curso:*

En esta función no implica esta situación "ya me lo sé no es necesario estudiarlo", necesitamos considerar lo siguiente: los comentarios de las encuestas anteriores al mismo curso, evaluaciones que generen las mismas, verificar las direcciones siguientes en Internet: <http://www.oracle.com>, <http://education.oracle.com>, <http://education.oracle.com/latinoamerica> y estar informados de las actualizaciones y en los cursos y los nuevos releases a los productos Oracle. Es importante estudiar los cursos de Oracle, mínimo con una semana antes de impartirlo, ya que a nuestras instalaciones llegan clientes con los siguientes perfiles: líderes de proyecto, gerentes, administradores, desarrolladores, usuarios finales entre otros; no todos los cursos se imparten de la misma manera. Aquí es importante considerar la creatividad ya que en ocasiones nuestros clientes toman series de cursos continuos donde el mismo instructor los imparte lo cual implica mejorar la técnica de estudio e impartición del curso.

#### *Evaluar el curso:*

En esta función se aplica un examen a cada participante del curso. Para ver el rendimiento adquirido durante las sesiones. Con respecto al curso realizamos una bitácora final donde registramos los comentarios de instalaciones, logística, materiales, metodología llevada durante el curso.

Este proceso se da para cada uno de los cursos impartidos.

### **Proceso de formación de gente interna.**

Es importante para nosotros el área de Oracle Educacional apoyar y formar al personal de otros departamentos del Centro de Servicios en Informática, realizándolo de la siguiente manera:

Primero consideramos el material existente, si tenemos material en stock de cursos que no se han impartido o de cursos que sean obsoletos y además disponibilidad de un instructor local; el objetivo es que se vaya fogueando y en futuro poderlo impartir como el caso de Blanca Idalia. El proceso es: realizamos una convocatoria informando a todas las áreas del Centro, consideramos cuales son los prerequisites al curso así como la cantidad de participantes. La gente involucrada es la siguiente: Maricarmen, Martín, Caty, Marisol, Edna, Jorge, y Capacitación.

Al final de estos cursos se verifica como en todos los demás la credibilidad de la información se evalúa al instructor y a los alumnos con encuestas y comentarios.

### **Proceso de formación de instructores.**

Para formar instructores en Oracle el proceso es el siguiente: Existen dos vías de autorización.

*Primera vía:* Aquí en Monterrey su atento y seguro servidor es la entidad autorizada para formar, evaluar y autorizar instructores en las áreas que en lo personal imparto incluyendo el tronco común. Cuando el instructor este listo se envía a México para su Vo. Bo. En alguna área diferente a la de su servidor, solo se prepara en tronco común y entra en los cursos como participante y después como segundo instructor en algún curso con instructor foráneo.

*La segunda vía:* es directamente en Oracle México con el coordinador correspondiente del área.

El hecho que formemos gente interna: es para tener mas salas, y me apoyen en la demanda de los cursos.

**Cada instructor local y foráneo debe considerar el siguiente decálogo:**

- Puntualidad
- Presentarse como instructor.
- Respetar la lista oficial de alumnos.
- Entregar el kit al participante, explicarlo y leer las políticas.
- Presentar el objetivo y alcance del curso.
- Respetar todos los horarios.
- Pasar lista diario.
- Aplicar las evaluaciones.
- Llenar la bitácora.
- Si surge algún problema ( de cualquier índole ), anomalía e inconformidad de algún alumno reportarlo inmediatamente.

**Proceso de evaluación de productos Oracle.***Solicitud del producto:*

En esta función nos apoyamos en las direcciones de Internet, para ver las tendencias a nivel Latinoamérica y a nivel mundial acerca de la tecnología de punta Oracle, así también de algún curso en puerta. Se solicita el producto con anticipación a soporte técnico: actualmente estos son los productos en puerta: Oracle 8i, Oracle 8i Lite, Developer/2000 ver 2, Developer/2000 ver 6, o en su caso algunos otro productos. En cuanto se tenga este producto: evaluar las características del mismo.

*Evaluación del producto:*

En conjunto con soporte técnico, evaluamos la instalación, novedades y que funcione, en su defecto si no funcionara en nuestros equipos, necesitamos o solicitar de nuevo el producto o acoplar nuestro equipo

*Evaluar el curso:*

Todos aquellos cursos que estén al alcance del Coordinador serán evaluados contra el material, practicas presentaciones, y productos en el cliente, en el servidor de aplicaciones o en el servidor de bases de datos. Implica mucho el producto, el curso nuestros equipos, posiblemente puedan ser días o semanas, para dar el Vo. Bo.

**Proceso revisión de encuestas Oracle.**

En esta función necesito dar el Vo.Bo. de lo que ocurrió al inicio, durante y al final de todos los cursos. Abarca los siguientes comentarios: Instructor, Curso, Material, Refrigerio o Logística, Equipo e Instalaciones, así como comentarios generales al mismo, en cada una de estas áreas necesitamos sacar 94 de acuerdo a las nuevas políticas de Oracle. En su defecto si tuvimos problemas comentarlo con cada responsable del área: Martín e Issachar son de soporte, Caty de Logística, Maricarmen y Marisol de ventas, en el caso de facturación con Caty y Maricarmen, y su servidor con cada uno de los instructores locales o foráneos.

Cuando se haya terminado cada curso las evaluaciones nos sirven de retroalimentación a cada una de las áreas, y al final del evaluación y revisión las archivo en las carpetas que sirven de histórico.

**Proceso revisión de inventario en Materiales.**

Se hace una revisión de los materiales, cuanto tenemos en stock y como andamos en reorder point, lo hacemos Caty y su servidor, no existe una fecha en especifico para esta actividad.

**Proceso autorización de cursos y certificación en áreas Oracle.**

Es muy importante en el mercado Oracle la certificación del profesionalista, actualmente hemos logrado la certificación de Developer/2000 ver 1 y vamos por la certificación de Developer/2000 ver 2. La importancia para nosotros como Centro Autorizado, es tener gente certificada y de gran interés formarla. Estamos en espera del Vo. Bo. , Para tomar cursos de actualización en las áreas de Designer/2000, Developer/2000 ver 6 y Oracle Application Server 4.0, el mercado lo requiere y no podemos quedarnos atrás, tenemos que ir a la vanguardia con tecnología de punta.

Espero que est documento le sirva como información sobre las actividades que realizo y con la gente que estoy en contacto.

## METODO DE EVALUACION DE LOS EXAMENES DE CERTIFICACION

Oracle frecuentemente publica nuevas versiones de exámenes de Certificación, se mantienen un standard consistente de eficiencia a través de las diferentes versiones del mismo examen, el pase del examen debe ser ajustado sobre la base de la dificultad de la nueva versión comparándolo con el nivel de dificultad de la anterior versión. Oracle puede publicar los nuevos release de los exámenes de Certificación y cambiar el pase sin notificar.

Por el momento el Pase para los exámenes de Certificación es de 620, hasta el mes de mayo de 1999 los rangos de evaluación del examen fueron entre 200 y 800 puntos, con un pase de 620 para cada examen. El sistema de evaluación para cada examen se considera los puntos de cada pregunta y varia entre los exámenes, los candidatos no pueden comparar sus registros entre exámenes. Oracle ha decidido abandonar esta escala y repartarla al registro de los candidatos.

Los cambios en los exámenes de certificación serán implementados a todos los exámenes de certificación se completaran en verano del 1999



- Use only Oracle-provided, Oracle-approved artwork.
- Follow the specified color, staging, and size guidelines as defined below.
- Use the logo proportionally as a whole. Do not change the size, design, or relative positioning of one line of type without proportionally changing the other.

## Correct Color

The OCP logo may be printed in one of four ways: 1) *Oracle* in red, *Certified Professional* and divider line in black, 2) entire logo in black, 3) entire logo reversed to white (against a dark background), or 4) *Oracle* in red, *Certified Professional* and dividing line reversed to white (against a dark background). The color specification of Oracle red is PMS 485 (100% magenta/100% yellow). The RGB specification is: 255 Red; 0 Green; 0 Blue.

## Staging and Size

“Staging” refers to the area directly surrounding the OCP logo. To ensure the logo’s visibility and integrity, the OCP logo must stand clear of all other elements such as type, images, margins, and other logos.

### Logo Clearspace

*The clearspace surrounding all sides of the logo is equal to height of the word “Oracle.”*




